### **Trees**

American Ash, seeded varieties (*Fraxinus americana*)  
Amur Maple (*Acer tataricum*)  
Buckeye or Common Horsechestnut (*Aesculus hippocastanum*)  
Black Locust (*Robinia pseudoacacia*)  
English Hawthorn (*Crataegus monogyna*)  
European Filbert (*Corylus avellana*)  
Fruiting Cherry species (*Prunus* spp.)  
Fruiting Plums (*Prunus* spp.)  
Green Ash, seeded varieties (*Fraxinus pennsylvanica*)  
Mountain Ash (*Sorbus aucuparia*)  
Norway Maple (*Acer platanoides*)  
Norwegian Sunset Maple "Keithsform" (*Acer truncatum* x *Acer platanoides*)  
Pacific Sunset Maple "Warrenred" (*Acer truncatum* x *Acer platanoides*)  
Tree of Heaven (*Ailanthus altissima*)

### **Shrubs**

Butterfly Bush (*Buddleia davidii*)  
Cotoneasters (*Cotoneaster* spp.)  
Common Privet (*Ligustrum vulgare*)  
Dog Rose (*Rosa canina*)  
European Cranberry Bush (*Viburnum opulus*)  
Spanish Broom (*Spartium junceum*)  
Sweetbriar Rose (*Rosa eglanteria*)

### **Ground Cover and Vines**

Ivy (*Hedera helix*)  
Multiflora Rose (*Rosa multiflora*)  
Periwinkle (*Vinca major*)  
St. John's Wort (*Hypericum calycinum*)  
Virginia Creeper (*Parthenocissus quinquefolia*)

### **Perennial and Grasses**

Fennel (*Foeniculum vulgare*)  
Giant Reed, or Cane (*Arundo donax*)  
Italian Arum (*Arum italicum*)

Lemon Balm (*Melissa officianalis*)  
Mints (*Mentha* spp.)  
Pampus Grass (*Cortaderia jubata*)  
Yellow Flag Iris (*Iris pseudoacorus*)
