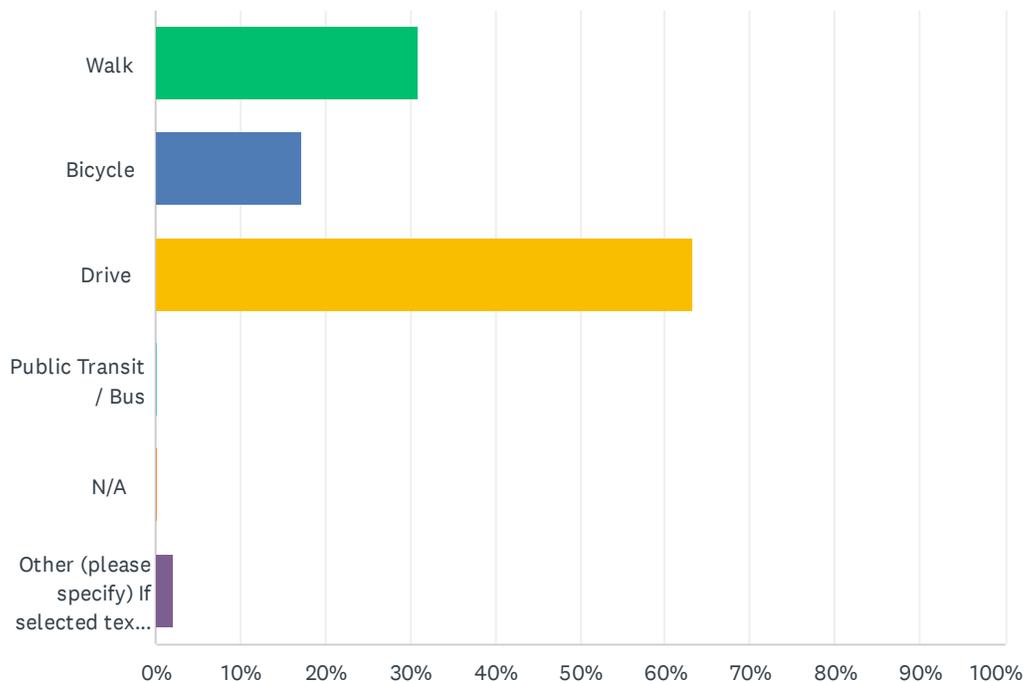


Q1 When you visit a park, recreation facility or senior facility, what is the primary way you get there? (check one)

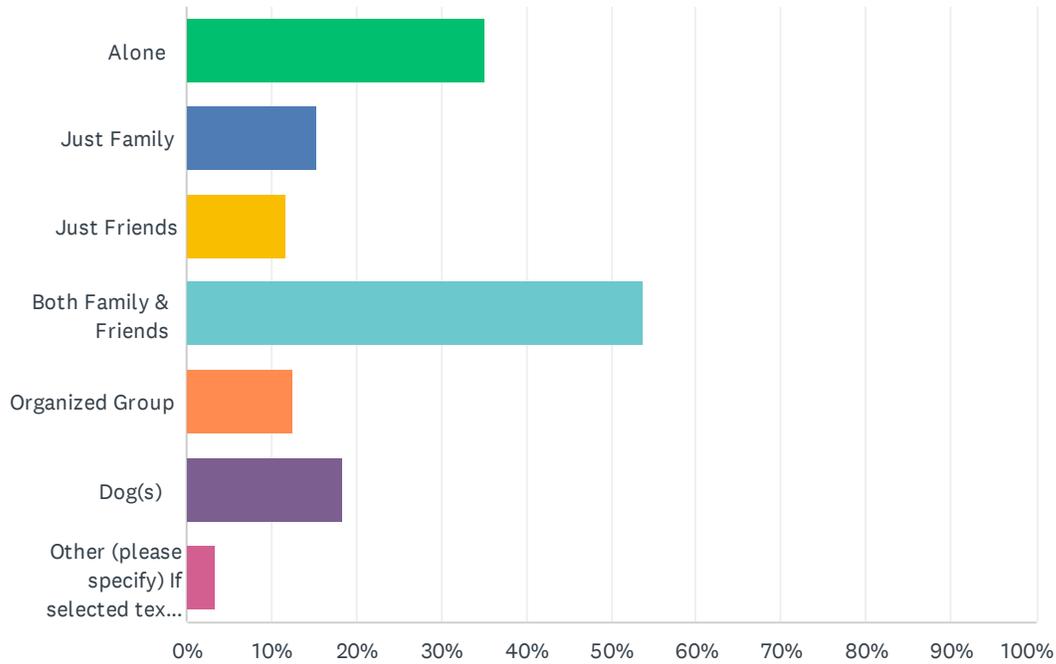

Q2 When you go to a City of Ashland park, open space, recreation program or senior services program, who do you usually go with?

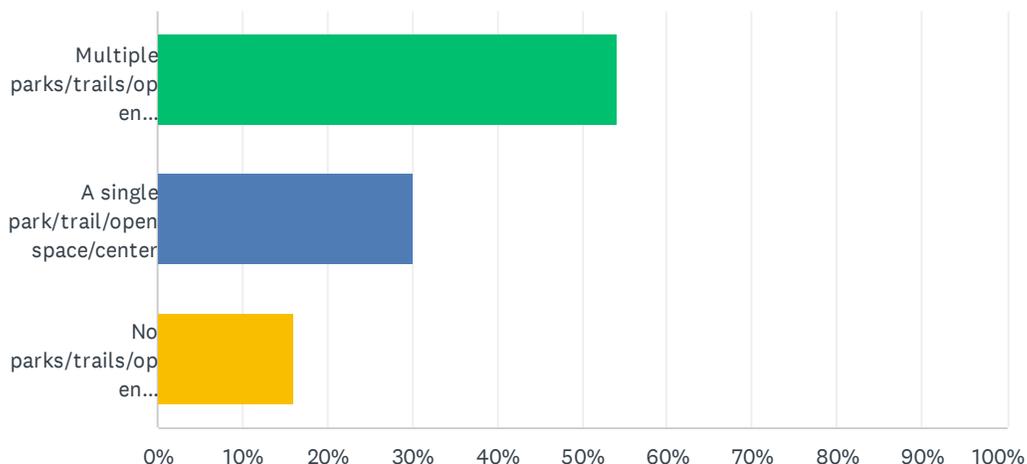

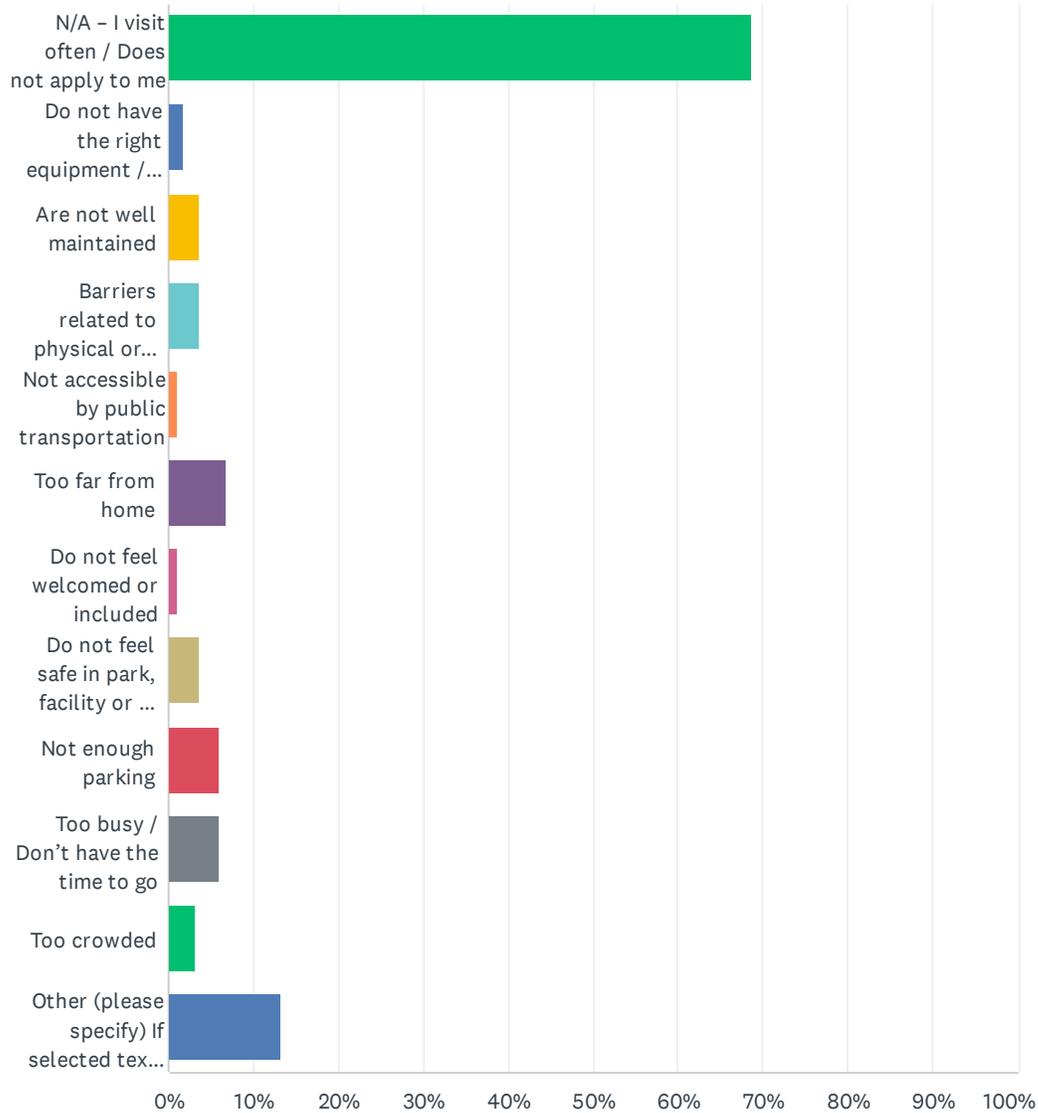

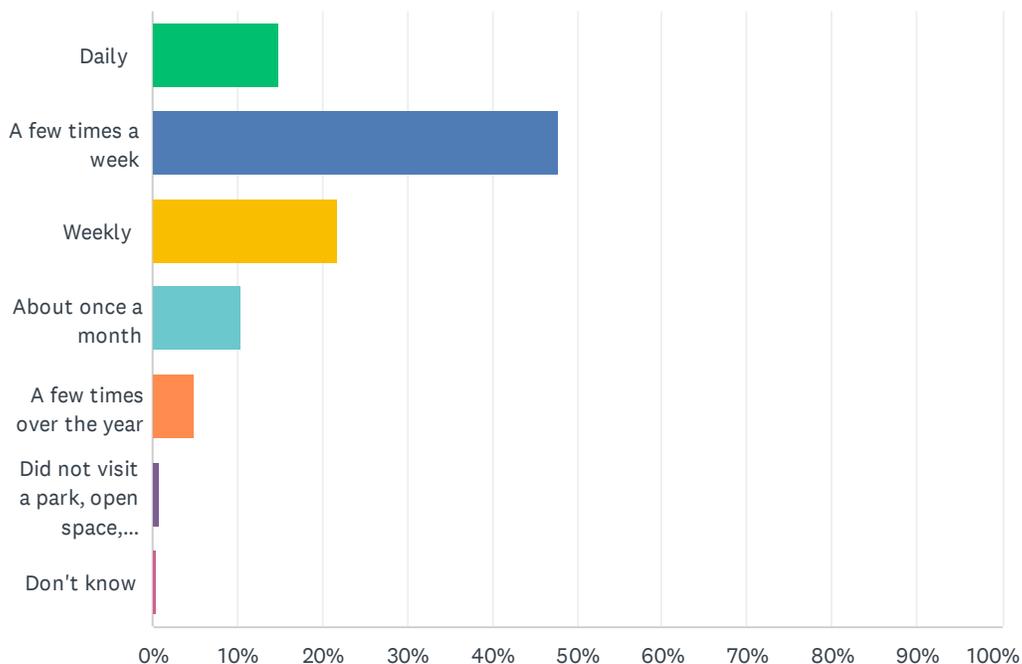

Q10 Please rate how important each trail type or amenity is to your household. (1 = not important | 3 = Neutral | 5 = very important)

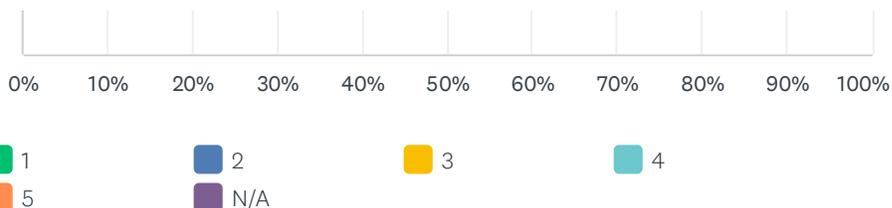
