



Community Wildfire Evacuation Drill Preparation Checklist – One Week Before

Use this checklist to get ready for Ashland's evacuation drill. A little preparation now makes the drill (and a real emergency) safer and smoother.

** For the October 11 drill our destination will be: **Ashland Municipal Airport 403 Dead Indian Memorial Rd, Ashland, OR 97520 (look it up).**

1. **Know your routes** – Learn two ways out of town: north and south.
2. **Pick meeting spots** – Choose one safe place north of town and one south where your family can reconnect.
3. **Plan for pets** – Gather carriers, leashes, food and water.
4. **Check your Go-Kit** – Stock it with water, snacks, medications, documents, flashlight, charger and cash.
5. **Update contacts** – Share your plan with family, friends and trusted neighbors.
6. **Plan transportation** – If you don't drive, decide who can help. If you do, think about who you could assist.
7. **Review home actions** – Inside: close windows/doors, turn off fans. Outside: clear flammables, shut garage.
8. **Talk with neighbors** – Encourage them to make a plan. Offer to help each other.
9. **Sign up for alerts** – Be sure you're registered with **Jackson Alerts**.
10. **Practice kindness** – Emergencies test us. Together, patience and lending a hand keep us strong.
